# M6, Jct 19 Project

The M6 junction 19 Improvement scheme is now complete and the two new link roads across the roundabout were opened for traffic mid-November and then the new traffic signals in Tabley were switched on. The new designated crossing point is now open for pedestrians and cyclists to use. Since the link roads opened, the contractors have been removing temporary traffic signals. This work has been done during overnight closures of the roundabout. The last overnight closure was planned for Friday 3rd December, after this date, no further closures of the roundabout are planned Tabley Parish Council thank its parishioners for their continued patience, during this project.

### News from St Paul's Church Over Tabley



### There are changes afoot as the New Year begins.

Revds. Philip and Patricia Robinson and Revd Trish Cope are retiring at the end of January, after just over six years at St Paul's. Revds. Philip and Patricia are moving to a village near Leek in Staffordshire, while Revd Trish will still be living in the area and will take services at St Paul's and other local churches from time to time. The plan for the future is that St Paul's will continue to work with the Churches at Rostherne and Little Bollington.

All the **alterations to the church have been completed** and there is now a lovely area at the back of church where we can hold meetings, refreshments following services together with an accessible toilet and a kitchenette.

The final piece of work was the asphalting of the path up to the church. Members of the church set out the kerbs and the contractors at J19 of the M6, Amey Sir Robert McAlpine, laid the asphalt as part of their engagement programme with the local community. Our thanks to everyone involved.

With the alterations complete we now hold our regular monthly **Community Coffee and Chat** meetings at church on the **2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of each month**. Everyone is welcome – you don't need to be a church member, it is open to all. Drop in anytime between 10.30 and 12.00 noon. Stay for a short time, a little longer, or the whole session.

The Annual **Plough Service** was held on Sunday 9 January. At the service we offered the work of the countryside to the service of God. A plough, the sign of the labour in the countryside, was brought into Church to be blessed during the service. Soil and seeds were also blessed.

#### Mere and Tabley Community Club

Along with its immaculate clubhouse and well-kept bowling green Mere & Tabley Community club remains the meeting venue for Tabley Parish Council.

This year we will observe Her Majesty The Queen become the first British Monarch to celebrate a Platinum Jubilee after 70 years of service. In honour of this a sub-committee has been formed and events will be taking place, watch this space.

After a quiet festive period, our Community Club is gradually getting back to normality. Due to the omicron variant, we had to postpone functions until a future date which obviously affects income. However, because our organisation is run by a team of volunteers, our overhead costs are low. Bookings are picking up with organisations like NHS blood donors using our hall on a regular basis. 'Knutsford Rex Probus' have commenced their fortnightly meetings and the flower arranging classes

resume next month. Short mat bowls remains popular with over twenty members participating both on Monday afternoons and Tuesday evenings. On Wednesdays we have a whist drive in the afternoon and fives and threes dominos in the evening. Our two snooker teams are now well into their league fixtures. The second team seems to be doing better than the first thanks to some savvy activity in the transfer market!

In the depths of winter, the outdoor bowling season may seem a long way off but work on the green continues year-round. Our men's meeting takes place on Sunday where the members decide the makeup of next seasons five teams in the Knutsford league. The Community Club is holding its AGM on Sunday 30th where we encourage people to come along and can see our facilities and ask questions or give ideas to the management committee.

Finally, we recently hosted a lunch in honour of the Reverends Philip and Patricia Robinson and Reverend Trish Cope who are retiring from their positions as the ministry team of Rostherne, Little Bollington, High Legh and Tabley churches. They have done such a tremendous job of bringing people together both in the church and wider community. Philip's many skills have seen all four churches now in a good state of repair, all now having toilet facilities and kitchens. Patricia and Trish's dedication and encouragement have been instrumental in maintaining regular services in all four churches. We wish them well in their retirement, although I am sure Philip will keep a string of projects on the go which Patricia will be thankful for!
