3.1 Cheshire East Ward Councillor report/updates

3.1.1 M6/ Jct 19 Traffic lights:

3.1.1.1 Cllrs updated that the lights have been lowered as requested.

3.1.2 Tabley Road/Tabley Hill Lane:

3.1.2.1 WCKP asked if anyone has made an enquiry into having a speed reduction on the road? If not, the resident or resident who is concerned about the speed limit must submit an enquiry through the Traffic Management Team, and this can be put forward for an assessment. Please note, TRO assessment and police data will be needed to support the reduction as it is based off an assessment criterion. **Q: BH:** Informed the Cllrs that he will share all the data regarding the speeding issue that has collected via email after the meeting

3.1.3 Old Hall Lane:

3.1.3.1 WCKP updated that an assessment would be needed for this and has confirmed that a request for this is to be looked into. As yet, no response has been received, but will be chased today.

3.1.4 Moss Lane:

3.1.4.1 WCKP will be meeting with the Highways team in the coming weeks to take a look at the area in a bid to getting action for this issue. Highways have had a wealth of emails about the matter and are fully aware of the severity of the issue.

3.2.1 Resolved that no updates have been received by HS2 representatives.

3.3 Knutsford Police

3.3.1 **Resolved** that the new PC John Millman and PCSO Chloe Shore will be starting and will be invited to the next meeting.

5.1.2 Matter arising:

5.1.2.1 Cllrs stated it was a travesty that Knutsford hospital has been demolished.

5.1.2.2 The minutes showed WCKP in attendance, but she was absent from the meeting.

6. Actions & Correspondence updates:

6.1 M6/ Jct 19 Traffic lights:

6.1.1 Action: PC wrote to WCKP to enquire who was responsible for the M6 JCT 19 roundabout now the work has been completed and the following was reported by the Parish Council.

The set of phased traffic lights located on the roundabout are very dangerous and confusing for motorists. The first set of lights direct traffic onto the M6 southbound carriageway whereas the next set of lights direct the traffic towards Manchester. Motorists are becoming confused as the lights are extremely close together. It has been suggested that the first set of lights (M6 Southbound) needs to be lowered to avoid a serious accident. This junction has been flagged up with the M6, Jct 19 representatives at earlier meetings but the issue has not been resolved.

Update: Cllr AG confirmed that a lower set of lights at the M6 Roundabout have recently been installed as we had previously asked for.

6.2 Tabley Road/Tabley Hill Lane:

6.2.1 Action: PC wrote to Cheshire Constabulary and CEC

With reference to our recent Parish Council meeting, the Council requested that we write to you or the Highways Officer, to request that a temporary speed limit on Tabley Road is set to 30mph, as there is no doubt a strong case for this request, given the increase in traffic levels due to the roadworks on Northwich Road and data collected. The speed of some of the traffic is unacceptable especially for pedestrians that like to visit the cemetery. I would appreciate it if you could feedback so I can update the Councillors.

6.3 Old Hall Lane:

6.3.1 Action: PC wrote to WCKP and CEC

Cllr Bailey has enquired if there is an update on Old Hall Lane. Cllr Bailey has reported that he water has actually stopped running. If you could feedback it would be appreciated.

Comments: Cllrs said the roundabout is too big and the bend is too tight and should be looked at as it is a design issue.

6.4 Moss Lane:

6.4.1 Update: Received from WCKP and CEC

The latest on Moss Lane is that it requires a Level 3 drainage improvement scheme to resolve the flooding issue experienced. This will be considered in a future program of works subject to available funding and prioritization via the council's asset management-led approach.
